You CAN qualify if:

- Are between 15 and 30 years old;
- Came to the United States before you were 16 years old;
- Have been living in the United States continuously since at least June 15, 2007;
- Were present in the United States on June 15, 2012;
- Are currently in school, graduated from high school, received a GED, or are a honorably discharged veteran of the Coast Guard or Armed forces; and
- Have passed a background check.
